Conventional Dock with Pallet Walker™ Trailer

- Pallets delivered to rear door of trailer for pick-up by lift trucks.
- Low initial investment.
- Reduce trailer damage because lift trucks no longer enter trailer.

Flush Mounted Dock

- Dock is flush with warehouse floor, eliminating "monuments."
- No interruption in traffic flow.
- Dock does not compromise warehouse space.

Freestanding Dock

- Minimizes installation costs.
- No elevated warehouse floor required.
- Semi-portable system for temporary warehousing.

Flush Mounted No Pit Dock

- No confined space.
- Lower retrofit cost for existing warehouse.
- Net storage capacity moved outside, maximizing space.

Surface Mounted Dock with Inverted Drive

- Low installation costs.
- Minimal modification required to existing dock area.
- Easy access to **WALKING FLOOR®** operational components.
